Key messages:

- 1) Fairtrade is about people.
- 2) Follow #FairtradeAtOxUni to learn why we care about Fairtrade, and how you can join in. Fairtrade empowers farmers and workers to improve their living standards, the welfare of their communities and our shared environment.
- 3) Fairtrade supports climate justice by working with those at the forefront of the climate crisis.
- 4) Fairtrade rallies a global community of millions farmers and workers, supply chain partners, brands, retailers, shoppers, schools, governments to pay fair prices and uphold fair production standards and practices.

5) Fair standards and practices promote sustainable farming to protect biodiversity and the environment. They also deliver training for women to participate and lead, secure worker rights, and help tackle climate change.

How to take part?

- 1) Join or host a Fairtrade Fortnight event in your college, department, Green Impact team, common room or anywhere else.
- 2) Look for the Fairtrade logo and buy Fairtrade products at University outlets, college dining and your local shop.
- Treat yourself to a special Fairtrade banana and chocolate loaf in Oxford Beyond Ordinary Cafe outlets.
- Get double point on Fairtrade products on the Teya app (replacing the Yoyo app).
- 3) Encourage your college or department to purchase Fairtrade products for your kitchen, meetings and events*.
